Please join the Wolf Conservation's Dana Goin in a discussion about coyotes, their history and ecology and what we can do to best coexist with them. Coyotes are explorers, opportunists and one of the most successful carnivores in N. America. Highly adaptable, the eastern coyotes have become exceptionally adept at living adjacent to humans, even thriving in large cities.

Dana Goin is the wildlife Outreach Specialist at the Wolf Conservation Center in South Salem, NY. She has a degree in Wildlife Conservation, and has worked in various areas around the country studying large and mid-sized carnivores including mountain lions, coyotes, bobcats and racoons.
