Local Law No. 2 of the year 2013

A local law moving the date for the hearing of complaints in regard to real property assessments to the Thursday following the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday in May.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the

Section 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT:

The Town Board of the Town of Livingston desires to move the date for the hearing of complaints to the board of assessment review to the Thursday following the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday in May to accommodate the town's assessor, who is employed in another municipality that causes a conflict as to the hearing date and the availability of the assessor to be present at the hearing date.

Such a change in date for hearing complaints is expressly permitted pursuant to the New York State Real Property Tax Law Section 512(1-a). Said section of law expressly provides for the change in date to accommodate an assessor who is at the same time employed by another municipality causing the conflict in hearing dates.

The Town Board, therefore, desires to move the hearing date, to the Thursday following the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday in May effective upon passage of this local law, until amended or repealed.

Section 2. ENACTMENT

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Livingston that pursuant to the authority of the New York State Real Property Tax Law Section 512(1-a), the hearing date for the hearing of complaints in relation to assessments upon property in the Town of Livingston shall be held on the Thursday following the fourth Tuesday in May.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately after passage.
