Each individual banner will be unique and honor a specific service member, past or present and will include their picture, name, rank, branch of service and military conflict in which they served.

This is a non-political and non-partisan project. It is purely a living memorial to recognize those that have served our country in the military, past and present. The banners will be 18 inches wide and 36 inches in height and be in full color. They will be displayed for as long as they last, an average of three years. At which time, they may be claimed by the sponsor at the Germantown American Legion Post 346. We cannot be responsible for damaged, vandalized, or missing banners.

We are looking at displaying them in Germantown, Cheviot, Clermont, Livingston, Linlithgo, Gallatin and Elizaville. The sponsor may select which hamlet, but the pole selection will be at our discretion.

Contributions towards the project are also accepted and appreciated.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Serviceman or women who is a resident of Southern Columbia County
- They must have served in the United States Armed Forces (Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Coast Guard) and be honorably discharged.
