

TRANSFER STATION POLICIES

RECYCLABLES:

- Recycling mandatory as of 11/1/89. **PERMIT REQUIRED**
- **COMMINGLED RECYCLABLES:** Tin and aluminum food and beverage cans, plastic bottles & food containers. Glass bottles (green, clear, brown) and aseptic containers (plastic coated milk and juice containers). Please make sure your recyclables are free from any outer packaging and lids/caps **AND MUST BE CLEAN OF FOOD & DEBRIS**. Do not flatten your tin and aluminum cans. Do not include antifreeze or motor oil bottles, as they are not recyclable – they should be placed with your garbage.
All recyclable paper products may be mixed together. These items include newspaper, corrugated cardboard, magazines, junk mail, office paper, brown kraft bags and phone books. Boxboard such as cereal, tissue and shoeboxes are also acceptable. All commingled paper should be placed in a brown paper bag or kept loose. ***NO PLASTIC BAGS!***
- **YARD WASTE:** Accepted at the **GREENPORT TRANSFER STATION ONLY**. Limbs should be no longer than 3 foot long & 2 inches in diameter. Grass and leaves are also accepted year round. ***There will be a \$5.00 minimum charge. Please check with office for fees.***
- **ELECTRONIC WASTE:** ***Accepted at Greenport Transfer Station ONLY, free of charge.***
- **WE DO NOT ACCEPT STYROFOAM:** It is considered household garbage and will be charged accordingly.

CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION DEBRIS: Large quantities must be brought to the Greenport Transfer Station. Please contact the station or the Solid Waste Administration Office at 518-828-2737 for further information pertaining to fees. ***The current price per ton in \$150.00.***

NO HAZARDOUS WASTE: Please contact our office for proper disposal.

ROLL OFF CONTAINERS ARE AVAILABLE: Please Contact 518-828-2737.

SCALE MINIMUM: There will be a \$10.00 minimum for use of the scale for all municipal solid waste and construction and demolition debris.

FEES APPLY TO THE DISPOSAL OF THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS:
COUNTY GARBAGE TAGS REQUIRED FOR BAGGED WASTE &
RECYCLING PERMITS ARE REQUIRED

Bags may be purchased at station by check or money order. Proof of Residency required for the recycling permits. Permits are valid from Jan 1st until Dec. 31st of each year. They are not prorated based on purchase date.
